

**KOI CARE**
**Pond pH Down**

pH adjuster



Sometimes pond water can become excessively alkaline. This can cause stress to fish and encourage the growth of unsightly algae.

The pH of pond water should be between 6.0 and 8.0. Test the water using a Pondlab pH Test Kit.

Take care when adjusting the pH of the pond water and only add sufficient Pond pH Down to reduce the pH by 1 unit every 24 hours.

It is also advisable to measure the KH of the water. This is a measure of the total amount of alkali in the water and should be about 6 degrees dH. If the KH is lower than this, do not add any pH down or the pH may fall too fast and too much causing stress to the fish.

In any case, a low KH is normally accompanied by a normal to low pH making the use of Pond pH down unnecessary but it is worth remembering.

**Dosage:**

Add 10 ml to 15 gallons (68 litres) of pond water.
